## Calendar for Village Elections

March 20, 2012

All documents are filed with appropriate Village.

Jan. 3	<b>First day to sign independent nominating petitions.</b>
Jan. 10 - 17	<b>First day to publish party caucus notice in newspaper (not earlier than 2 weeks prior to caucus) depending on date of caucus.</b>
Jan. 17- 23	<b>Dates to post and file in office of village clerk, notice of party caucus, depending on date of caucus. (At least 10 days before caucus.)</b>
Jan. 24 — 31	<b>Dates for holding party caucus.</b> NOTE: Party officials must either (a) publish notice of caucus in a newspaper not more than two (2) nor less than one (1) week before the caucus, or (b) (b) post notice of the caucus in six (6) public places in the village at least ten (10) days before caucus.
Jan. 26- Feb. 2	<b>Dates for filing certificate of party nomination.</b>
Feb. 6	<b>Last day to file certificate of acceptance or declination of party nomination.</b>
Feb. 7-14	<b>Dates for filing independent nominating petitions</b>
Feb. 8	<b>Last day to fill vacancy caused by declination of party nomination.</b>
Feb 17	<b>Last day to file certificate of acceptance or declination of an independent nomination.</b>
Feb. 17 Mar. 9 April 16	<b>Dates for filing statements of receipts and expenses for village elections, as per New York State Board of Elections Rules and Regulations.</b>
Feb. 21	<b>Last day to file certificate filling vacancy caused by declination of an independent nomination.</b>
Mar. 9	<b>Last day for voter to register with Board of Elections to vote in village election.</b>

<b>Mar. 13</b>	<b>Last day for Village Clerk to receive an application for an absentee ballot to be mailed to a voter.</b>
<b>Mar. 16</b>	<b>Last day for voting machine inspection by candidates or representatives. (15<sup>th</sup> if Village using BOE Opscan)</b>
<b>Mar. 19</b>	<b>Last day for applicant (or his agent) to personally deliver application for an absentee ballot to the Village Clerk.</b>
<b>Mar. 20</b>	<b>Election Day</b>
